

# Endemic, Resident & Migratory Birds Conservation in the Turks and Caicos Islands

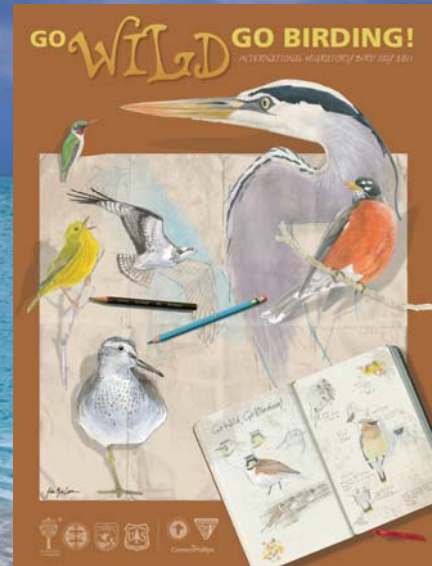
**TCI provides favourable environmental conditions for waterbirds, but in recent time there have been challenges to their survival.**

## Steps to make birds happy & productive

1. Keep dogs & cats away from waterbirds.
2. Maintain a pollution-free environment.
3. Protect wetlands and other bird habitats.
4. Promote responsible development initiatives.
5. Strict implementation of environmental laws; adhere to anti-hunting and bird protection legislation.
6. Encourage government to support International Treaties & Convention, e.g. Ramsar, CITES, etc.
7. Support Bird Monitoring & Conservation Initiatives, such as Caribbean Endemic Bird Festival (CEBF) and International Migratory Bird Day (IMBD).
